



## **OSHA 10-Hour General Industry Outreach Training Program** *(Customized for Boatyard, Yacht Club, and Marina Employees)*

The program provides training for workers and employers on the recognition, avoidance, abatement, and prevention of safety and health hazards in workplaces. **Course Outline:** Each topic is approximately one hour. Day One covers mandatory safety topics set by OSHA guidelines. Day Two covers topics that are of critical importance to boatyards, yacht clubs and marinas.

### **Day One Topics**

- Introduction to OSHA
- Walking and Working Surfaces
- Means of Egress and Fire Protection
- Electrical Safety
- Flammable and Combustible Liquids

### **Day Two Topics**

- Hazard Communication
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Machine Guarding
- Lockout/Tagout
- Fall Protection
